GOVERNMENT OMNIBUS (FARES) AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 2015

The Minister responsible for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 9 of the Public Transportation Act 1951, makes the following Regulations:

Citation

1 These Regulations, which amend the Government Omnibus (Fares) Regulations 1952 (“the principal Regulations”), may be cited as the Government Omnibus (Fares) Amendment Regulations 2015.

Amends regulation 2

2 Regulation 2 of the principal Regulations is amended by inserting in proper alphabetical order the following—

“adult” means a person who has attained the age of sixteen years;”.

Amends regulation 3

3 Paragraph (2) of regulation 3 is amended—

- (a) in subparagraph (b) by deleting the word “and”;
- (b) in subparagraph (c) by deleting the full stop and replacing it with “; and”;
and
- (c) by inserting after subparagraph (c) the following—

“(d) a special person on production of a special transportation identification.”.

Revokes and replaces the Schedule

4 The Schedule to the principal Regulations is revoked and replaced with the following—
