INSTRUCTIONS

How to read the bottle label

The label has two lines.

The first line is the Best Before Date, it is read day/month/year 01/02/2019 = February 1 2019

The second line is a package code and a time code
The package code will contain the numbers 49, 52 or 55
The next four digits are a time code, it is read hour:min







Do you only have the carton? How to read the carton code:

If you have a 12-pack, 18-pack or 24-pack, this is what you look for on the side of the carton: The carton code has two lines:

The first line is a Best Before Date, it is read day/month/year 01/02/2019 = February 1 2019

The second line is the package code
The package code will contain the numbers 49, 52 or 55
The next four digits are a time code, it is read hour:min
