the seeds long since sown, the influence of Bermudian ecologist and Pan-Africanist Dr. Pauulu Kamarakafego, and Dr. Edward Carpenter founder and Head Master of the Harlem Preparatory School for Dropouts, have blossomed into the character of Mr. Watson, who has reaped and multiplied their influence, love, and teachings to uplift and serve fellow African-Americans; and
