Mr. E.D.G. Burt to move the following Motion:

WHEREAS the World Health Organization has declared COVID-19 to be a global pandemic;

AND WHEREAS COVID-19 continues to be an unprecedented and severe threat to public health in Bermuda;

AND WHEREAS, in accordance with section 14(6) of the Constitution and section 18(2) of the Emergency Powers (Covid-19 Shelter in Place) Regulations 2020, (“the Regulations”), the House of Assembly and Senate resolved on 6 April 2020 to extend the proclamation of emergency and the duration of the Regulations until 6am on 18 April 2020, and communicated that fact by message to the Governor;

BE IT RESOLVED that, pursuant to section 14 (6) of the Constitution, that this Honourable House approves the continuance of the state of emergency until 6 am on 30 June 2020.; and the continuance of the Regulations until 6am on 2 May 2020, pursuant to section 18(2) of the Emergency Powers (Covid -19 Shelter in Place) Regulations 2020.
