The Ministry of Public Works wishes to inform motorists that the Stokes Point Road and Mullet Bay Road to Echo Lane junction in St. George's trench work is still ongoing and will require a one-lane closure. This trench work is finishing up the Stokes Point Road trench work in the westbound lane and then will proceed on Mullet Bay Road and head down the eastbound lane until it reaches Echo Lane at Ferry Reach Road.

All residents will still be granted access to Stokes Point Road and are advised not to park on Stokes Point Road at any time.

The lane closure will continue from Monday June 14<sup>th</sup> 2021 to Saturday July 3rd, 2021. Working hours will be from 7:30 am to 6:00 pm, weekly from Monday through Saturday and trench work should reach 200 feet section lengths at a time once trench enters Mullet Bay Road.

Motorists are asked to use caution when passing the open trench since it may be near to the center yellow line and can be quite deep.

Traffic controls will be under the direction of D&J Construction Co. Ltd. and Ministry of Public Works representatives and will be managed through traffic control signs & signals.
