PROCLAMATION

By Her Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Bermuda.

WHEREAS Section 49 of the Constitution provides that the Governor, acting in accordance with the advice of the Premier, may at any time, by proclamation published in the Gazette, prorogue the Legislature:

NOW THEREFORE I, the Governor, acting in accordance with the advice which I have received from the Premier, DO PROROGUE THE LEGISLATURE on Thursday, the 4th day of November, two thousand and twenty-one.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of Bermuda this 1st day of November, two thousand and twenty-one, in the seventieth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
