LANE CLOSURE EXTENSION II FOR BELCO TRENCH WORK

ONGOING UNTIL FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 2nd, 2022

The Ministry of Public Works wishes to inform motorists that BELCO will be continuing their trenching work from Old Military Road across Parson's Lane heading northeasterly to Palmetto Road's westbound lane. From there work will continue along Palmetto Road to tie into the completed trench works just east of the Bus Depot entrance.

The lane closure will be ongoing until Friday September 2nd, 2022. Working hours will be from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm daily, Monday through Sunday.

Motorists are asked to avoid this lane closure section on Old Military Road, Parson's Lane and Palmetto Road by using alternative routes via Robert's Avenue, Frog Lane or Middle Road for the duration of this trench work.

Dame Marjorie Bean Hope Academy and the Governments Prospect Depot will still be accessible from Parson's Lane south off of Orange Valley Road.

Traffic controls will be under the direction of BELCO representatives and will be managed through traffic control signals and directional signs during rush hours.

Motorists are advised to drive cautiously through the construction sites and avoid speeding to protect themselves and construction workers on site.

The Ministry of Public Works wishes to encourage the full cooperation of the public and apologizes for any inconvenience that may result.
