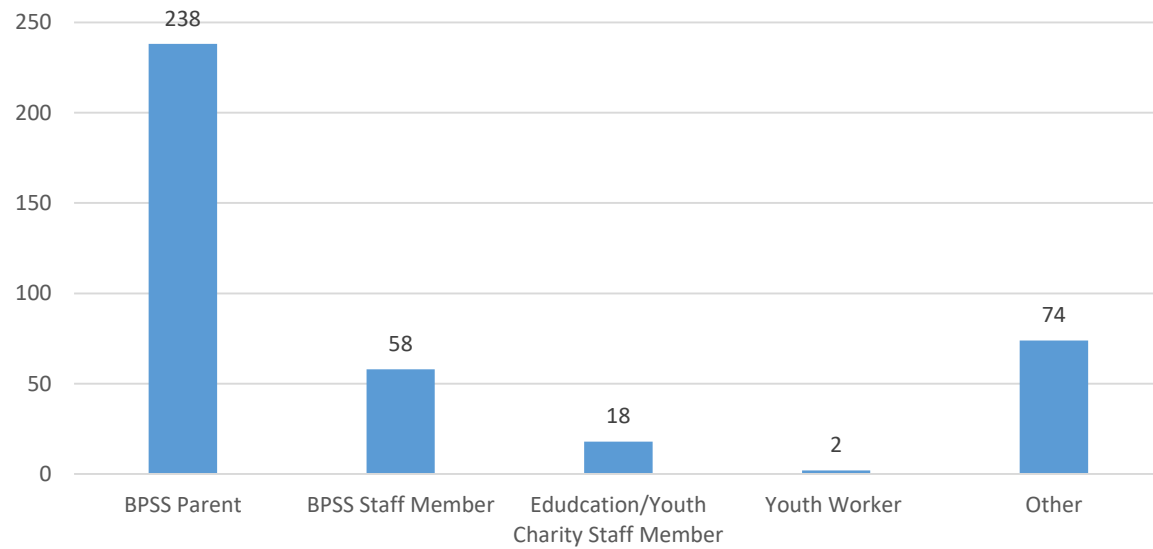

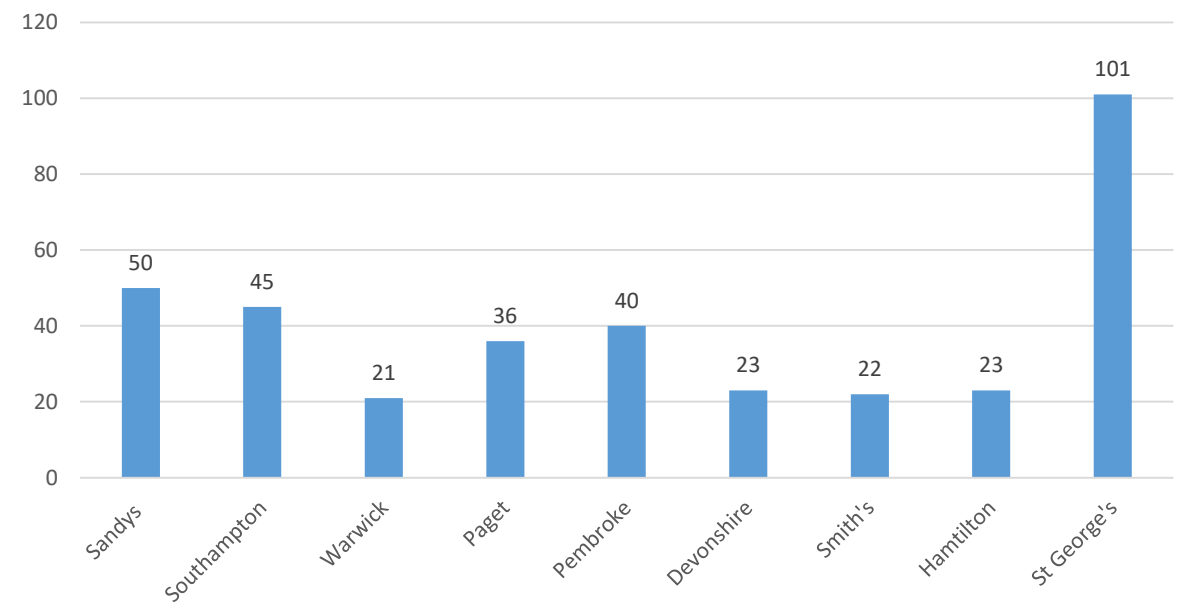
Parish Primary Schools Survey: Summary

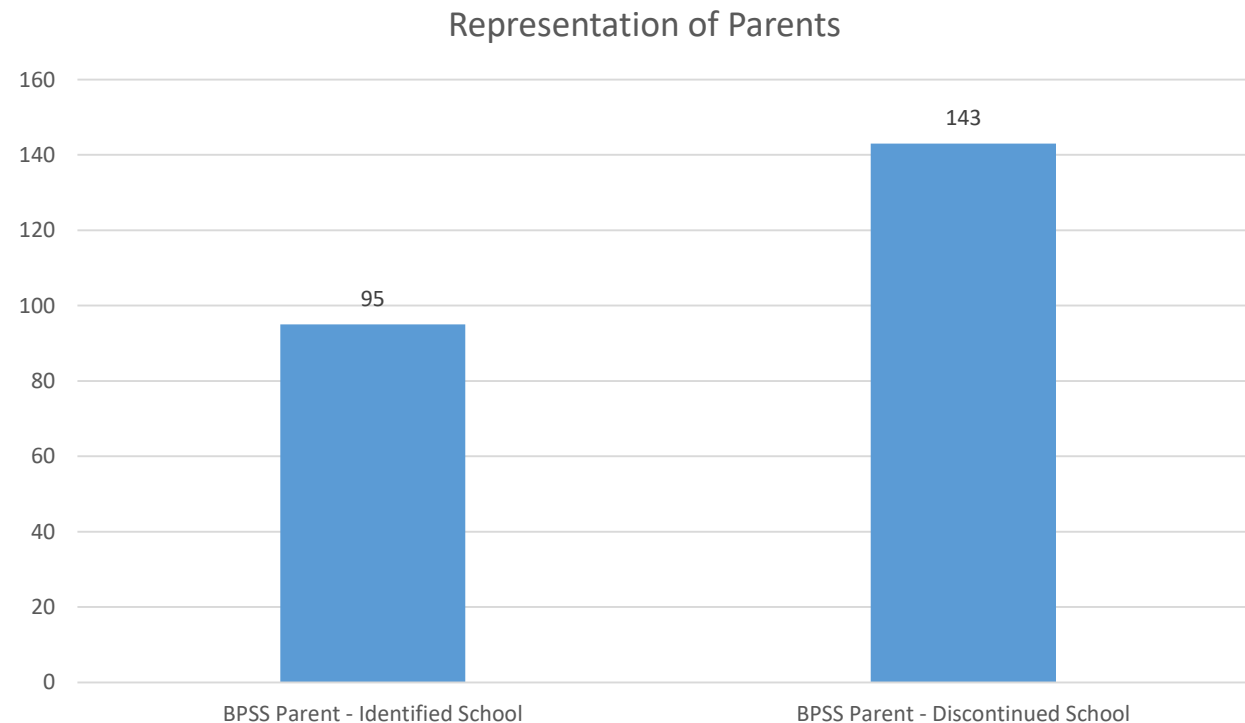

Parish Primary Schools Survey: Summary

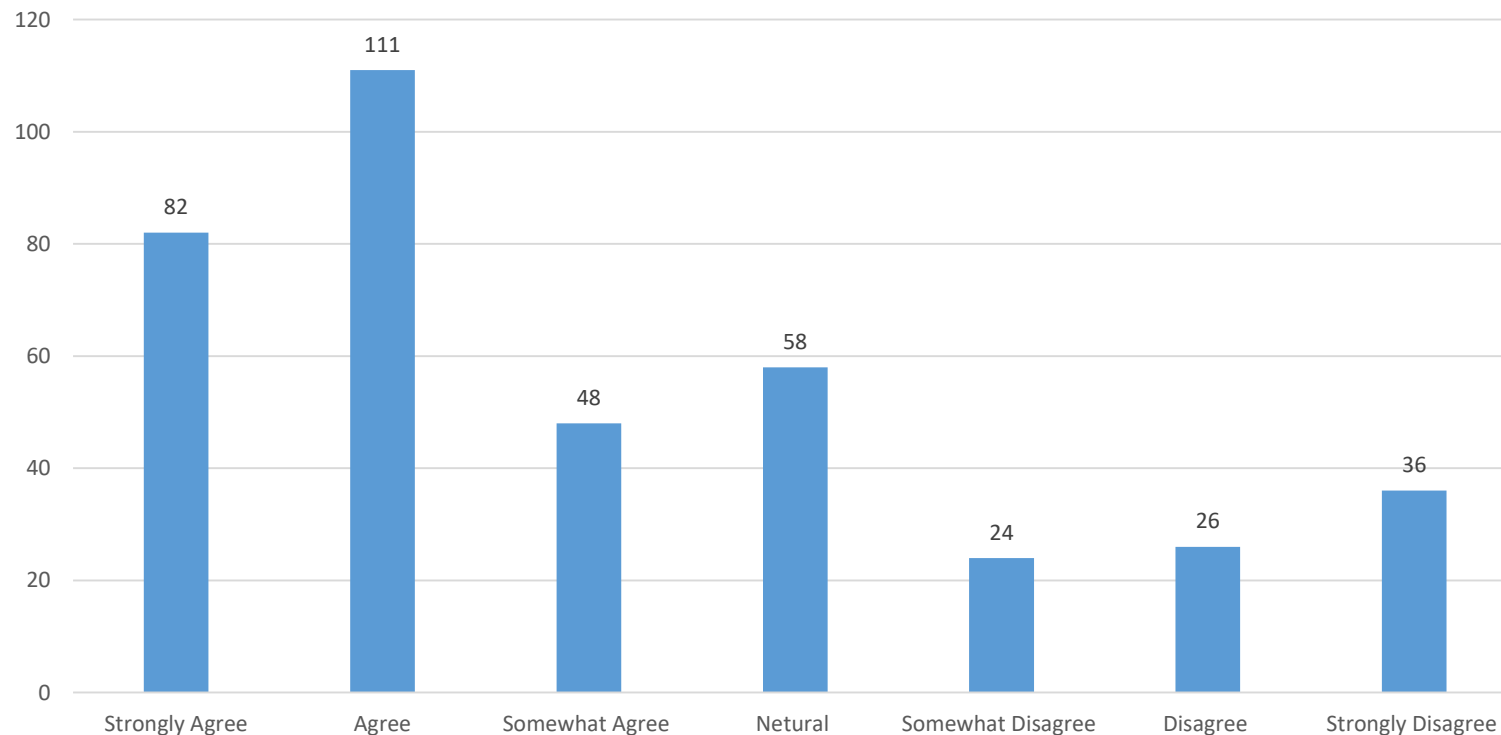
Of the 238 parents who completed the survey 40% were parents of schools identified as parish primary school sites. 60% were parents of schools currently identified to be discontinued.

“The idea to establish one primary school per parish was still being developed when presented to the public.”

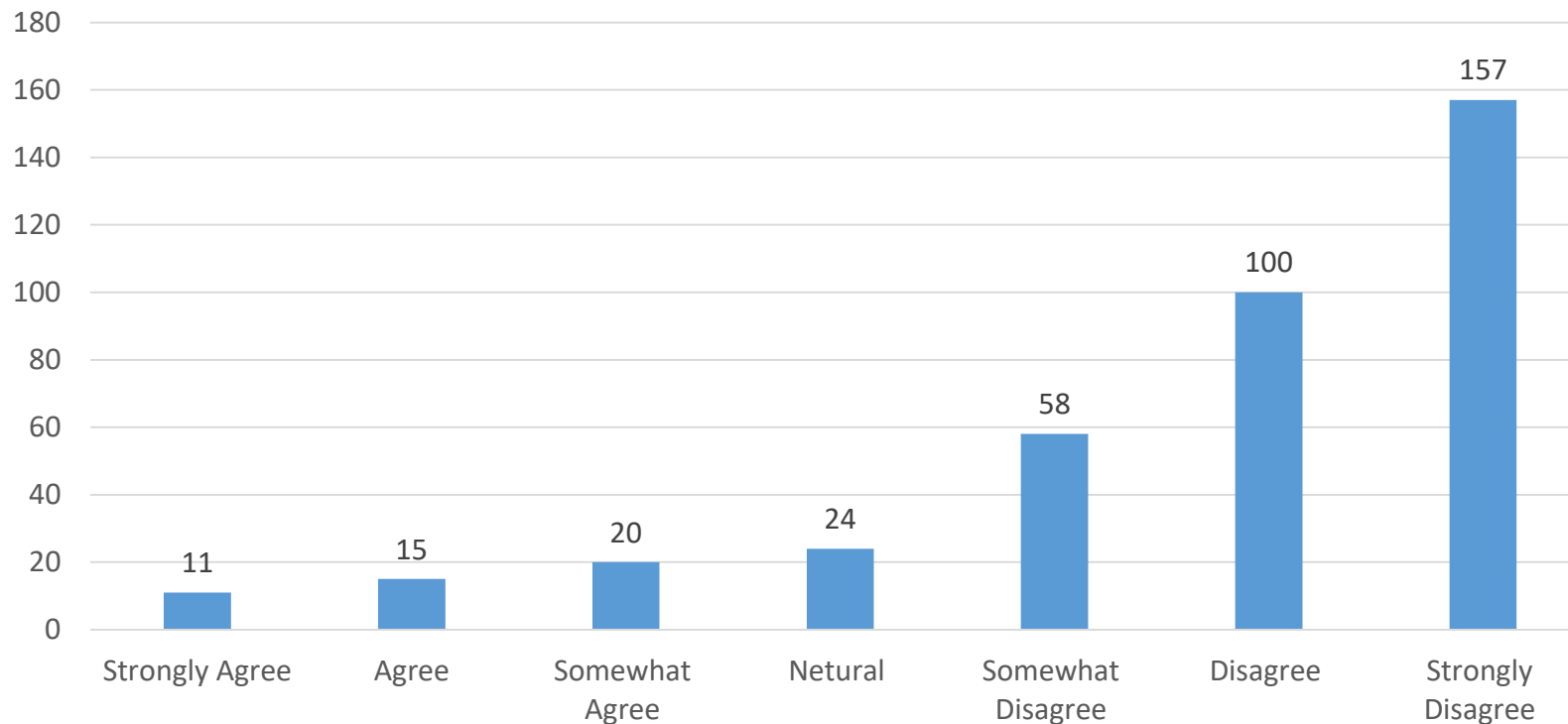
62% AGREE | 15% NEUTRAL | 22% DISAGREE

“The public had a say in whether or not we should establish one primary school per parish.”

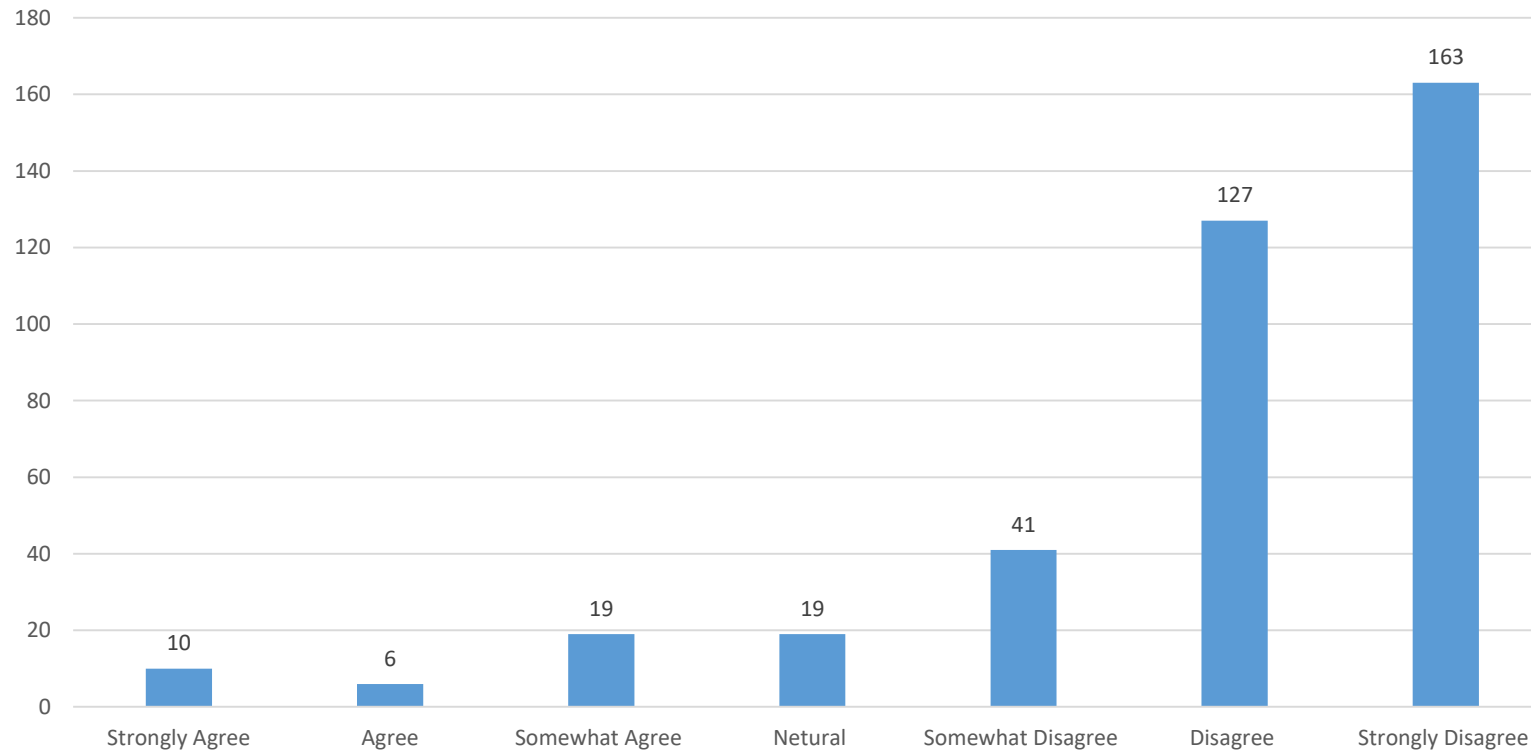
12% AGREE | 6% NEUTRAL | 82% DISAGREE

9% AGREE | 5% NEUTRAL | 86% DISAGREE

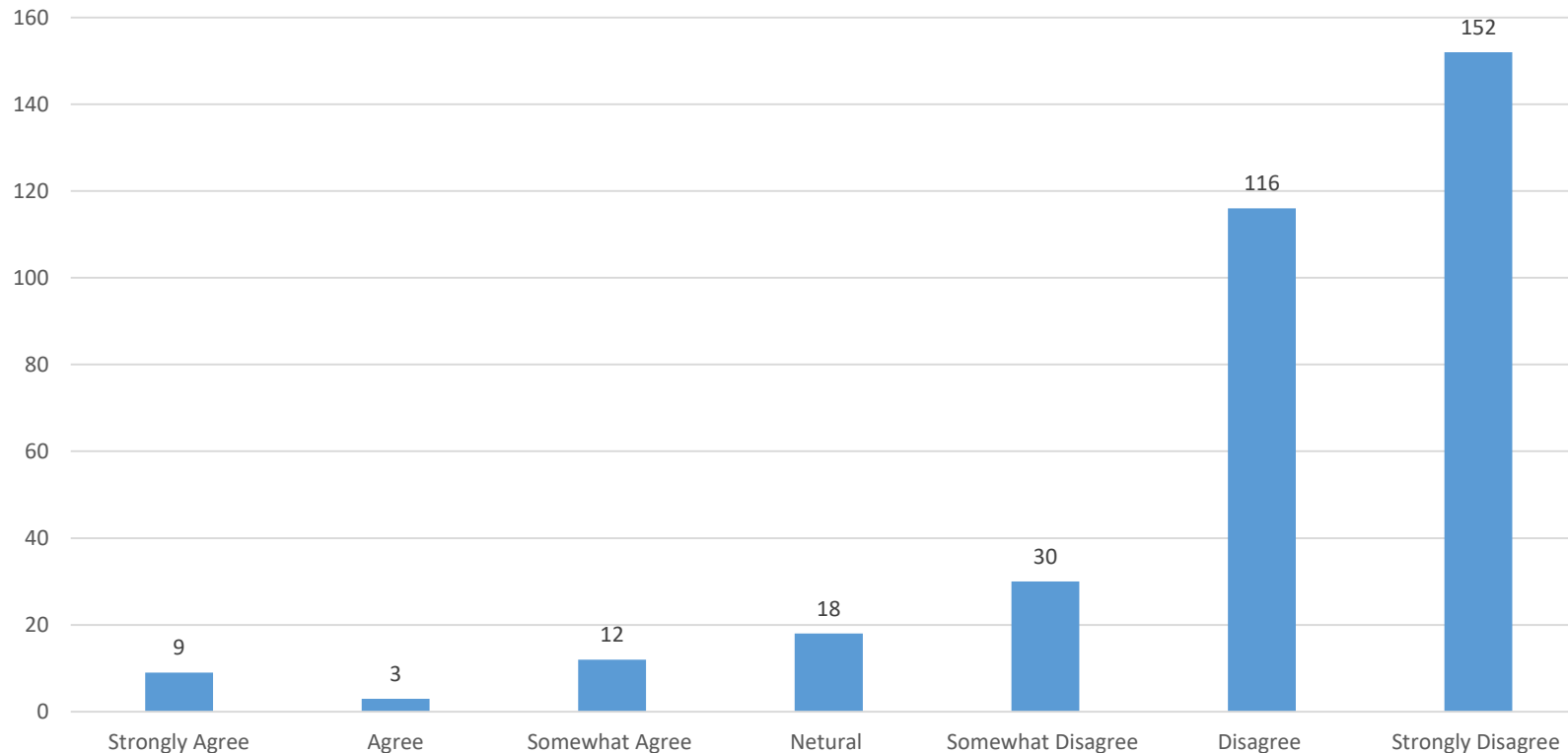


Parish Primary Schools Survey: Summary

(This question received 340 responses)

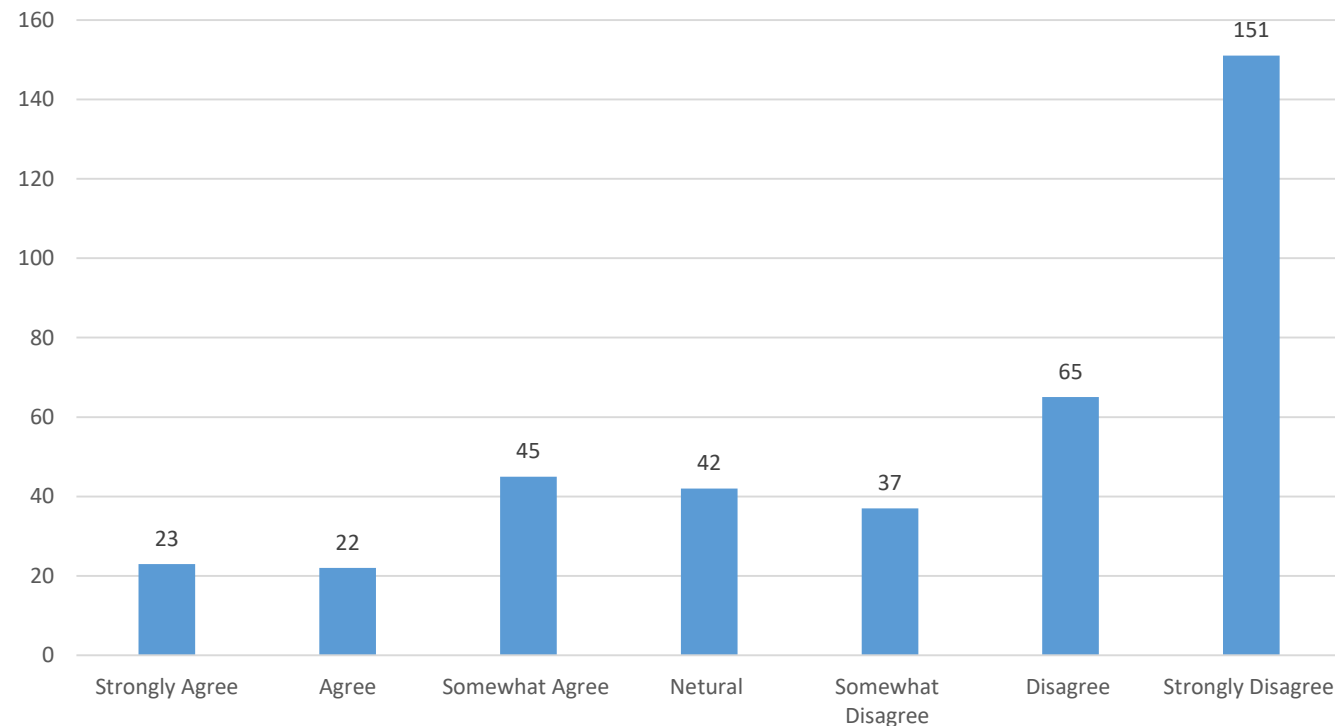
7% AGREE | 5% NEUTRAL | 88% DISAGREE
