LANE CLOSURE EXTENSION II FOR BLDC TRENCH WORKS

EXTENDED UNTIL FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 30th, 2022

The Ministry of Public Works wishes to inform motorists that the ongoing BLDC's trench work from Rocky Hill Park to Ferry Reach Road will continue to require a one lane closure up until 30th September, 2022.

The trench work will be switching over into the eastbound lane on Mullet Bay Road at Ferry Reach Road to tie into the Echo Lane trench.

Working hours will be from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm, weekly from Monday through Saturday.

Motorists, especially construction vehicles, buses and taxis are asked to use caution when passing the open trench since it may at times be near the center yellow line and can be quite deep.

Traffic controls will be under the direction of Island Construction Services Ltd. representatives and will be managed through traffic control signs and signals.

LANE CLOSURE EXTENSION III & TRAFFIC FLOW CHANGE FOR BELCO TRENCH WORK

EXTENDED UNTIL FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 30th, 2022

The Ministry of Public Works wishes to inform motorists that BELCO will be continuing their trenching work from Old Military Road across Parson's Lane to head northeasterly to Palmetto Road's westbound lane. From there work will continue along Palmetto Road to tie into the completed trench works just east of the Bus Depot entrance.

Once trench work reaches Palmetto Road, Palmetto Road's traffic flow will be changed to only allow traffic to flow eastward. Westbound lane will be rerouted to North Shore Road from roundabout. Motorists wanting to gain access to Tynes Bay Facility, will have to detour via North Shore Road to Dock Hill to reach Palmetto Road.

The lane closure will be ongoing until Friday September 30th, 2022. Working hours will be from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm daily, Monday through Sunday.

Motorists are asked to avoid this lane closure section on Old Military Road, Parson's Road and Palmetto Road by using alternative routes via Robert's Avenue, Frog Lane, North Shore Road, Dock Hill or Middle Road for the duration of this trench work.

Traffic controls will be under the direction of BELCO representatives and will be managed through traffic control signals and directional signs during rush hours.
