**SOMERSFIELD ACADEMY FUN RUN AND WALK
IN DEVONSHIRE PARISH**

SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 29TH, 2024

The Ministry of Public Works wishes to inform motorists that the Somersfield Academy Fun Run and Walk will occur on Sunday, September 29th, 2024, between 9:00 am and 10:00 am. The following roads will be affected:

RACE ROUTES: The 1 mile race commences and finishes at the Somersfield Academy school grounds. The participants turn right onto Middle Road and continue along Middle Road to the turnaround point located just before Brighton Hill Road. They turn around, continue East on Middle Road, and proceed to the finish line.

The 5 km race commences and concludes at the Somersfield Academy school grounds. The participants turn left onto Middle Road and make another left onto Store Hill. They turn left onto North Shore Road and proceed to the roundabout. The participants exit the roundabout onto Barkers Hill and turn left onto Parsons Lane. They turn left onto Middle Road and proceed to the finish line.

TRAFFIC CONTROL: The race will commence on Sunday, September 29th, 2024, at 9:00 am and is expected to conclude by 10:00 am. There will be Police Officers and Race Marshals present to direct traffic along the route.

ROAD CLOSURES: There will be no road closures for this event. All motorists are expected to use caution and avoid collisions with the race participants. The race will be under the control of Police Officers and Race Marshals. Motorists are asked to follow the instructions given by the Police Officers and Race Marshals to assist with traffic control for this event.

The Ministry of Public Works wishes to encourage the full cooperation of the motoring public and apologises for any inconvenience that may result. Should there be any questions regarding this event, please direct queries to the attention of the race representative, David Lunn at 514-0144.

In addition, the Bermuda police are hereby authorised to “Close-Off” streets or portions of streets and authorise parking as the Commissioner of Police decides.
