**LANE CLOSURE FOR ROAD PAVING WORKS ON GEORGE’S BAY AND MIDDLE  
ROAD, SOUTHAMPTON**

**MONDAY, MARCH 10<sup>th</sup>, 2025, TO THURSDAY, APRIL 10<sup>th</sup>, 2025**

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment wishes to inform the motoring public that the paving works on Middle Road in Sandy’s will be switching over to George’s Bay Road in Southampton. To do so, a one-lane closure will be implemented for George’s Bay Road from Middle Road to the Railway Trail the week of Monday, March 10<sup>th</sup>, 2025.

Once the paving work on George’s Bay Road is completed, the works will return to Middle Road and continue to Evans Bay Road. We anticipate a one-lane closure for these works to commence by Monday, March 17<sup>th</sup>, 2025.

The working hours will be weekdays from 7:30 am through to possibly 6:00 pm.

The traffic controls will be under the direction of Ministry of Public Works and Environment representatives with traffic lights and stop-and-go signs.

**During the paving works on Middle Road, eastbound traffic will be detoured via the Railway Trail from George’s Bay Road through to Tribe Road No. 5 to connect back to Middle Road.** Buses and emergency vehicles heading eastbound will still be allowed to head down Middle Road with the assistance of Ministry of Public Works and Environment representatives.

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment encourages the full cooperation of the motoring public and apologises for any inconvenience that may result.
