**BERMUDA BICYCLE ASSOCIATION VT CONSTRUCTION ROAD RACE**

**SUNDAY, 18<sup>th</sup> MAY 2025**

The Ministry of Public Works & Environment wishes to inform motorists that the Bermuda Bicycle Association VT Construction Road Race will occur on Sunday, May 18<sup>th</sup> 2025, between 8:00 am and 11:00am. The following roads will be affected:

**RACE ROUTE:** The race commences and concludes on Middle Road (near Whitney School). The participants proceed west and turn left on Vermont Road, left on St. Marks Road, and left on South Road. They travel east along South Road and turn left onto Paynters Road before turning left onto Harrington Sound Road. The participants turn left onto Middle Road and proceed to the finish line.

**TRAFFIC CONTROL:** The bicycle race will commence on Sunday, May 18<sup>th</sup> 2025, between 8:00 am and 11:00am. All motorists are expected to use caution and avoid collisions with race participants. The race route will be controlled by Police Officers and Race Marshals. Motorists must follow the instructions from the Police Officers and Race Marshals to assist with traffic control for this event.

**ROAD CLOSURES:** There will be no roads closed to traffic while the road race takes place.

The Ministry of Public Works & Environment wishes to encourage the full cooperation of the motoring public and apologises for any inconvenience that may result. In addition, the Bermuda Police are hereby authorised to “Close off” streets or portions of streets and authorise parking as the Commissioner of Police decides.
