SINGLE-LANE CLOSURE & ONE-WAY WESTBOUND TRAFFIC FLOW IMPLEMENTATION MIDDLE ROAD FROM CROW VALLEY TO STORE HILL, SMITH PARISH, FOR WALL INSPECTION WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 27th, 2025, TO FURTHER NOTICE

The Ministry of Public Works & Environment wishes to inform the motoring public that a single-lane closure and one-way westbound traffic flow will be implemented on Middle Road from Crow Valley to Store Hill in Smith Parish. This traffic flow change is necessary to facilitate a compromised wall inspection and repair, and will remain in place, 24 hours a day, until further notice.

The one-way westbound traffic flow will commence from Crow Valley through to Store Hill. Eastbound traffic will continue to be rerouted via Store Hill Road down to North Shore Road and Verdmont Road to Middle Road.

Residents from Crow Valley to Store Hill will have to follow the one-way traffic flow to access their private roads.

In the interim, paving works will continue from Peak Lane down to North Shore Road daily on the eastbound lane. A temporary single-lane closure will be enforced from 9 am to 4 pm for these works.

Traffic controls will be under the direction of Ministry of Public Works representatives, utilizing barricades, signs, cones and manpower.

To avoid congestion, during the temporary single-lane closure, motorists are encouraged to use detours via Harrington Sound Road and North Shore Road
