**FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 5<sup>th</sup>, 2025**

The Ministry of Public Works & Environment wishes to inform the motoring public that the Bermuda Football Association will be holding the FIFA World Cup at the National Sports Centre – Flora Duffy Field, Friday, September 5<sup>th</sup>, 2025.

The event will require a **lane closure on Frog Lane for the northbound lane from Montpelier Road through to Devon Lane**. Motorists will only be allowed to travel south from Devon Lane to Montpelier Road. Northbound traffic will be detoured via Parsons Road or to the event parking areas.

The lane closure will take place from 5:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.

Traffic controls will be under the direction of Bermuda Football Association representatives & the Bermuda Police Service, utilizing barricades, signs, and cones.

**During the lane closure, motorists attending the event should expect delays. Please follow the instructions of the event Marshals and Police representatives once entering Frog Lane from the roundabout.**

**Motorists who are not attending the event are advised to avoid Frog Lane and detour via Parson's Road, Palmetto Road or Middle Road.**

The Ministry of Public Works & Environment encourages the full cooperation of the motoring public and apologises for any inconvenience that may result.
