1) Background

Red Hole Dock (the "Site") is owned by the Paget Parish Council and has, for as long as local memory serves, been used as a working **boat yard**. The Council is inviting **Expressions of Interest (EOIs)** from qualified parties to lease and activate the Site from **Spring 2026**. While the Council's strong preference is for **marine-related use**, proposals for other compatible uses will be considered where they demonstrate clear community benefit and respect for the waterfront setting and neighbours.

Note: 18 boats currently lease **walk-on moorings** alongside the boatyard area. Uses that remain compatible with these moorings are encouraged.

2) The Opportunity

- Premises: Red Hole Dock, Paget (see attached drawings and photographs).
- Current / historic use: Boatyard and associated marine activity.
- Existing context: 18 walk-on moorings in the immediate vicinity also owned by Paget Parish Council
- Examples of suitable uses (illustrative, not exhaustive):
 - o Boatyard / haul-out / repair (subject to permits).
 - Dry or in-water boat storage facilities.
 - Club headquarters or training base for a small boat, sailing, rowing, or paddling organisation.
 - Marine services hub (e.g., rigging, chandlery, tender shuttle, coaching).

3) Lease & Commercial Terms

- Lease term: 5 years
- Guide rent: USD \$7,000 per month (exclusive of utilities, taxes, insurance, maintenance and any government fees).
- Commencement target: Spring 2026 (subject to agreement and any required approvals).
- Permitted uses: Marine-related use strongly preferred; other uses considered where compatible with the site, neighbours and moorings.
- **Compliance:** The successful proponent will be responsible for obtaining and maintaining all required licences, permits, insurances and regulatory approvals (including planning and environmental compliance) for their proposed use.

4) Evaluation Approach

EOIs will be assessed by the Council in the best interests of Paget residents, with emphasis on: - Community benefit & compatibility with the waterfront setting and existing moorings.

- Alignment with preferred marine-related use (or clear justification for any alternative).
- Operational feasibility & capability (experience, safety, staffing, hours).
- **Environmental stewardship** (noise, waste, spill prevention, and upkeep of the adjacent small beach).
- **Commercial terms** (rent proposal, investment, value for money).

5) What to Include in Your EOI

Please submit a concise proposal (PDF preferred, max 10-12 pages) that includes:

- 1. **Proponent details**: entity name, principals, contact information.
- 2. **Proposed use & concept summary**: what you will operate at Red Hole and why it suits the site.
- 3. **Operations plan**: staffing, hours, seasons, equipment, site access and traffic/parking assumptions.
- 4. **Compatibility with existing moorings** (18 walk-on berths) and any interface you propose.
- 5. **Community benefit**: programmes, memberships, public access, training, youth initiatives.
- 6. Environmental management: noise, waste, fuels/chemicals, spill plans.
- 7. Commercial proposal: rent (responding to the \$7,000/month guide or proposing an

alternative), any capital investment, requested lease options.

- 8. **Timeline**: mobilisation and any works required to achieve **Spring 2026** opening.
- 9. Experience & references relevant to marine or proposed operations.
- 10. Insurance & compliance: summary of coverages and key permits anticipated.

6) Process & Timelines

- EOI closing date: 31 October 2025.
- Evaluation & shortlist: November 2025.
- Negotiation & Council decision: December 2025—January 2026.
- Target lease commencement: Spring 2026.

The Council reserves the right to accept or reject any EOI, to negotiate with one or more proponents, and to issue a subsequent Request for Proposal (RFP) process if deemed in the community's best interest.
