**29<sup>th</sup> ANNUAL BREAST CANCER AWARENESS WALK  
PARKING BAY CLOSURES ALONG BARR’S BAY PARK**

**WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 15<sup>TH</sup>, 2025**

The Ministry of Public Works wishes to inform motorists that the 29<sup>th</sup> Annual Breast Cancer Awareness Walk will occur on Wednesday, October 15<sup>th</sup>, 2025, between 4:30pm and 7:30pm.

To accommodate the event, the parking bays along Barr’s Bay Park will be closed off to the public from 7:00am until about 7:00pm.

For the walk the following roads will be affected:

**WALK ROUTE:** The walk commences at Barr’s Bay Park on Front Street. The participants exit right, make a right turn onto Woodbourne Avenue and then turn left onto Richmond Road. They turn right onto Rosemont Avenue and make another right turn onto Serpentine Road. They proceed to the roundabout where they exit left onto Woodlands Road. The participants turn right onto Euclid Avenue, then right onto St. John’s Road to proceed to Cedar Avenue. They proceed straight to Burnaby Street and turn right onto Front Street to head to the finish point at Barr’s Bay Park.

**TRAFFIC CONTROL:** The walk will commence on Wednesday, October 15<sup>th</sup>, 2025, at 4:30pm and is expected to conclude by 7:30pm. There will be Road Marshals present to direct traffic along the route. All motorists are expected to use caution and avoid collisions with the walk participants. Motorists are asked to follow the instructions given by the Road Marshals to assist with traffic control for this event.

**ROAD CLOSURES:** There will be no road closures for this event.

The Ministry of Public Works & Environment wishes to encourage the full cooperation of the motoring public and apologises for any inconvenience that may result. In addition, the Bermuda police are hereby authorised to “Close-Off” streets or portions of streets and authorise parking as the Commissioner of Police decides.
