SALTUS RUN/WALK

SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 23RD, 2025

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment wishes to inform motorists that the Saltus Run/Walk will occur on Sunday, November 23rd, 2025, between 2:00 pm and 4:00 pm. The following roads will be affected:

RACE ROUTES:

The 1-mile race commences and finishes at the Saltus Campus Field on Woodlands Road. The participants proceed South on Woodlands Road, then turn left onto Canal Road. They proceed to the roundabout where they exit onto Laffan Street. The participants turn left onto Cedar Avenue and continue on St. John's Road to the roundabout. They exit onto Woodlands Road and proceed to the finish line at the Saltus Campus Field.

The 5k race commences and finishes at the Saltus Campus Field on Woodlands Road. The participants proceed South on Woodlands Road, then turn left onto Canal Road. They proceed to the roundabout where they exit onto Laffan Street. The participants turn left onto Cedar Avenue and continue on St. John's Road, then turn right onto Berkeley Road. They turn left onto North Shore Road and continue to the junction of Spanish Point Road and St. John's Road. They turn left onto St. John's Road and continue to the roundabout at Woodlands Road. They exit onto Woodlands Road and proceed to the finish line at the Saltus Campus Field.

TRAFFIC CONTROL:

The race will commence on Sunday, November 23rd, 2025, at 2:00 pm and is expected to conclude by 4:00 pm. Police Officers and Race Marshals will be present to direct traffic. All motorists are expected to use caution and avoid collisions with the race participants. Motorists are asked to follow the instructions of Police Officers and Race Marshals to assist with traffic control for this event.

ROAD CLOSURES:

There will be no road closures for this event.

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment wishes to encourage the full cooperation of the motoring public and apologises for any inconvenience that may result.
