There will also be single-lane closure on Verdmont Road to complete paving work previously carried out on Collectors Hill.

The single-lane closures is ongoing and will continue through Friday, 13th March 2026.

Working hours will be from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm.

The traffic controls will be under the direction of representatives from the Ministry of Public Works & Environment, using stop-and-go signs.
