PUBLIC HEALTH (COVID-19 EMERGENCY POWERS) (NO. 3) AMENDMENT  
(NO. 2) REGULATIONS 2021

Her Excellency the Governor, on the advice of the Minister responsible for health, and in exercise of the power conferred by section 107B of the Public Health Act 1949, makes the following Regulations:

Citation

1 These Regulations, which amend the Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) (No. 3) Regulations 2020 (“the principal Regulations”), may be cited as the Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) (No. 3) Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 2021.

Amends regulation 4

2 In regulation 4 of the principal Regulations—

- (a) in paragraphs (1), (2) and (4), delete “10 persons” and substitute “25 persons”; and
- (b) in paragraph (3), delete subparagraph (ca).

Amends regulation 5

3 In regulation 5(1A) of the principal Regulations—

- (a) delete subparagraph (a) and substitute—
  - “(a) in both indoor and outdoor areas of bars and clubs, only table service from the bar is permitted;”;and
- (b) delete subparagraph (d).

Amends regulation 8

4 In regulation 8(2) of the principal Regulations, delete “10 persons” and substitute “25 persons”.

5 These Regulations shall come into effect at 6am on 21 January 2021.
